ADVICE

1. Make your thesis statement VERY clear and direct. You will get a higher score for Task Achievement and Coherence if your essay is clear and everything matches this statement.

EXAMPLE

I agree with this view because prevention measures save money in the long term and reduce the incidence of disease.

2. The topic sentences are COHERENT with the Thesis statement.

EXAMPLES

- a. Firstly, treatment for patients can be very expensive, so preventing a disease saves money for both the patient and the health system.
- b. The second reason why prevention is more deserving of government spending than treatment is that it saves people from suffering from preventable diseases and medical conditions.

ADVICE

- 1. You need to practise planning as well as writing good thinking produces good writing.
- 2. In an opinion or argument driven essay, you need to show that you understand the other side first (CONCESSION) and then argue against that side (REBUTTAL) this is common in a higher level essay.

3. And know how to write an argument by addressing the 'other side' first.

EXAMPLES

- a. While this concern with the increased consumption of unhealthy food is correct, the idea that banning the advertising will fix the problem is misdirected.
- b.it has been suggested that prohibition of fast food advertising will aid the fight against lifestyle disease and obesity. However, this does not solve the problem of continued consumption.
- 4. Also, vary your vocabulary and word forms for the same idea e.g. ban restrict, be banned, be restricted, outlaw, make something illegal

ADVICE

1. Take a minute or two to analyse the essay question. That way, you can 'respond' properly and get a high score for Task Achievement.

In this case:

- Only write about business people, not other types of travel
- List advantages first
- List THE MAIN disadvantage second
- You do not need to give your opinion in this essay, however, it is advisable to end with some recommendation or 'position'
- 2. Then make a very quick plan most times you cannot write this out fully, but you still need a plan!

Notice that this introduction does NOT have an opinion in the THESIS STATEMENT – this is OK for this essay because the instruction asks you to list the advantages and disadvantages. It does NOT ask you for your opinion.

- 2. Remember a good introduction need only have 3 sentences
 - background information
 - introduce the topic and paraphrase the essay question
 - state your thesis (thesis statement) in an argument essay (to what extent do you agree or disagree OR what do you think) this will have a clear opinion, but in a discussion essay you can just provide a guide to the essay

EXAMPLE

Throughout history, humans have used animals for food work, research and even just for pleasure. While some people believe this exploitation to be unjust, others say it is a necessary part of human survival. Both of these viewpoints will be explored in his essay.

3. Because it is a discussion essay, you need good expression to introduce the ideas and opinions of other people as well.
